Plumbers do much more than unclog drains and run pipes. Plumbers design, install, and maintain water systems that move through municipal treatment plants before serving residential, commercial, and public buildings. Students are introduced to the plumbing profession as they learn to install heating, water, and drainage systems as well as safely assemble, install, and repair pipes and fittings according to specification and plumbing codes.

HVAC/R1 #AP02000

Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC) systems are integral parts of commercial, residential, and industrial buildings. Students learn techniques and skills needed to install, diagnose, repair, and maintain these increasingly complex systems. The National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) curriculum prepares students for success in this in-demand industry.

Electrical 1 #AP01000

Students develop skills in the installation, operation, maintenance, and repair of residential, commercial, and industrial electrical systems. They also study electrical theory, navigate the National Electrical Code Book, select and install conductors, and work with panelboards, switchboards, and generators.

Apprenticeship Core #AP08000

NCCER Core is designed as a rigorous, competency-based, industryrecognized introduction to construction skills. Modules cover topics such as Basic Safety, Communication Skills, Introduction to Construction Drawings, and Construction Careers.

Each class is the first in a four-level comprehensive curriculum aligned to the Department of Labor and Industry Registered Apprenticeship standards. Classes meet twice weekly, once in person and once virtually. Tuition includes an online textbook, and students may purchase a hard copy for an additional fee.

The National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) provides standardized training and industry-recognized credentials via a system of assessment and certification. The NCCER registry allows craft professionals to create and maintain their records while employers can access and verify the credentials of current and potential employees.
